Membership entitles each member to a vote at the Chevra Mishnayes Annual General Meetings. One vote for a single membership, and two votes for a married couple/common law couple if a family membership is purchased. Every individual over 28 years old must purchase their own membership as they are no longer qualified to fall under the family membership of a parent. For individuals 28 years of age and under, and are unmarried and still living at their parent's home, the membership fee will be waived. If seats are purchased for un-named family members, the membership purchased must be a Family Membership.
